The South Africa (United Nations Arms Embargo) (Prohibited Transactions) (Amendment) Order 1981

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas under Article 41 of the Charter of the United Nations the Security Council of the United Nations have, by a resolution adopted on 4th November 1977, called upon Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom and all other Members of the United Nations to apply certain measures to give effect to a decision of that Council in relation to the Republic of South Africa:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 1 of the United Nations Act 1946(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the South Africa (United Nations Arms Embargo) (Prohibited Transactions) (Amendment) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 23rd December 1981.

Amendment of the South Africa (United Nations Arms Embargo) (Prohibited Transactions) Order 1978

2. The South Africa (United Nations Arms Embargo)(Prohibited Transactions) Order 1978(b) shall be further amended by the substitution, in Article 3(3), of "Export of Goods (Control) Order 1981"(c) for "Export of Goods (Control) Order 1978".
