The Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges & Exemption) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1981

Made - - - 27th November 1981
Laid before Parliament 1st December 1981
Coming into Operation 2nd December 1981

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(1) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949(a) as enacted, and as extended by the Wireless Telegraphy (Channel Islands) Order 1952(b) and the Wireless Telegraphy (Isle of Man) Order 1952(c), and now vested in him(d), hereby, with the consent of the Treasury, makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges & Exemption) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 2nd December 1981.
- 2. The Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges & Exemption) Regulations 1970(e) shall be amended by substituting in the third column of Schedule 3 to those Regulations—
 - (a) for "£12", in all four places, "£15"; and
 - (b) for "£34", in all four places, "£46".
- 3. The Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges & Exemption) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1979(f) are hereby revoked.
