The Pipe-lines Act 1962 (Metrication) Regulations 1981

Made--5th May 1981Laid before Parliament14th May 1981Coming into Operation1st July 1981

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 49(1), (2) and (4) of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974(a) ("the 1974 Act") and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and for the purpose of giving effect without modifications to proposals submitted to him by the Health and Safety Commission under section 11(2)(d) of the 1974 Act after the carrying out by the said Commission of consultations in accordance with section 50(3) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as The Pipe-lines Act 1962 (Metrication) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1981.

Amendment to substitute a metric unit for an imperial unit

2. In section 23(2)(a) of the Pipe-lines Act 1962(b), which relates to the pressure at which a pipe-line may be operated, for the words "such number of pounds per square inch as may be specified" there shall be substituted the words "such number of bars as may be specified".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend section 23(2)(a) of the Pipe-lines Act 1962 so that the maximum pressure at which a pipe-line is operated is expressed in metric units (bars) instead of in Imperial units (pounds per square inch).
