**FARRIERS REGISTRATION COUNCIL**

**The Farriers (Registration) Act 1975 (Commencement No. 3)  
Order 1981**

*Made* - - - - *8th May 1981*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 19(3) of the Farriers (Registration) Act 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Farriers (Registration) Act 1975 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1981.

2. Section 16 of the Farriers (Registration) Act 1975(b) shall on 1st November 1981 come into force in Scotland, with the exception of the following areas:—

- (i) Highland Region
- (ii) Western Isles Islands Area
- (iii) Orkney Islands Area
- (iv) Shetland Islands Area, and
- (v) all other islands.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order brings into force in Scotland, with the exception of the areas specified, on 1st November, 1981 the provisions of section 16 of the Farriers (Registration) Act 1975 (offences by unregistered persons). The Act, except for section 16, came into force throughout Great Britain on 1st January 1976 (S.I. 1975/2018), and, in England and Wales, section 16 was brought into force on 1st June, 1979 (S.I. 1978/1928).
