The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland, the Secretary of State for Wales and the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 1(1) and (5), 3(1) and 5(7) of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964(a), (extended to Northern Ireland by the Plant Varieties and Seeds (Northern Ireland) Order 1964(b) and to the Isle of Man by the Plant Varieties and Seeds (Isle of Man) Order 1969(c) and now vested in them(d) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consultation in accordance with section 1(5) of the said Act with the Controller of Plant Variety Rights and with representatives of such interests as appear to them to be concerned, hereby make the following scheme:—

Title and commencement

1. This scheme may be cited as the Plant Breeders' Rights (Saintpaulia) Scheme 1982 and shall come into operation on 31st August 1982.

Interpretation

2. In this scheme:—

“the Act” means the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964;

“plant breeders' rights” means rights which may be granted in accordance with Part I of the Act.

Plant varieties for which plant breeders' rights may be granted

3. There are prescribed for the purposes of the grant of plant breeders' rights all plant varieties of Saintpaulia which conform to the characteristics of cultivated plant varieties of the species *Saintpaulia ionantha* H. Wendl.

Period for which rights are exercisable

4. The period for which plant breeders' rights shall be exercisable in respect of the plant varieties referred to in the last paragraph shall be 15 years.

Class of plant varieties for the purposes of Section 5(7) of the Act

5. In relation to the varieties referred to in paragraph 3 of this Scheme, the class of plant varieties hereby prescribed for the purposes of section 5(7) of the Act (which enables a class of plant varieties to be prescribed in connection with the use of names likely to deceive or cause confusion) consists of all plant varieties of *Saintpaulia*.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Scheme.)

This Scheme prescribes the varieties of *Saintpaulia* in respect of which grants of plant breeders' rights may be made and also prescribes the period of 15 years as that during which the rights may be exercised.

The Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964, as read with this Scheme, provides that infringements of the rights in the registered name of a variety of *Saintpaulia* may be the subject of legal proceedings when committed in connection with any variety of that genus.
