**The British Museum (Natural History)
(Authorised Repositories) Order 1982**

Made - - - - - 26th August 1982

Laid before Parliament 9th September 1982

Coming into Operation 1st October 1982

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 10(2) of the British Museum Act 1963(a) and vested in the Secretary of State(b), the Secretary of State for Education and Science, with the agreement of the Trustees of the British Museum (Natural History), hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the British Museum (Natural History) (Authorised Repositories) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1982.

2. Part II of Schedule 3 to the British Museum Act 1963 (authorised repositories for the collections of the British Museum (Natural History)) shall be amended by the addition of the following paragraphs:—

“3. The site in Tring lying to the West of Akeman Street known as 67–69 Akeman Street.

4. The site in South Ruislip known as Government Buildings 18, 19 and 20, at Victoria Road.”.
