## COUNTRYSIDE

**Wildlife and Countryside (Claims for Compensation under section 30) Regulations 1982**

The Secretary of State for the Environment as respects England, the Secretary of State for Scotland as respects Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales as respects Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 30(2), (3) and (10) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981(a), hereby make the following regulations:

*Title, commencement and interpretation*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Wildlife and Countryside (Claims for Compensation under section 30) Regulations 1982, and shall come into operation on 21st October 1982.

(2) In these regulations, “the Act” means the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

*Time within which claims are to be made*

2. A claim for compensation under section 30(2) of the Act shall be made within six months from the date on which the Secretary of State gives notice under paragraph 6(1) or (2) of Schedule 11 to the Act of his decision in respect of the order to which the claim relates.

3. A claim for compensation under section 30(3) of the Act shall be made within six months from the expiration of the period specified in section 29(5)(c) of the Act, as modified by section 29(6) or (7) of the Act.

4. The Secretary of State may, if he thinks fit, at any time extend the period within which a claim for compensation is required to be made under regulation 2 or 3 above.

*Manner in which claims are to be made*

5. A claim for compensation under section 30(2) or (3) of the Act shall be made to the Nature Conservancy Council in writing and shall be delivered at or sent by pre-paid post to the offices of the Council.
