2. Annual fee to be paid by every registered person	When required by the Registrar but in any event not more frequently than once annually	£40.00
3. On entry of a candidate for the intermediate examination or any part or parts thereof	At the time of presenting name	£40.00
4. On entry of a candidate for the final qualifying examination or any part or parts thereof	At the time of presenting name	£80.00

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules amend the Register of Patent Agents Rules 1978 by increasing the maximum registration and examination fees which may be charged by the Chartered Institute of Patent Agents. The fees numbered 1 to 3 were formerly £25 and the fee numbered 4 was formerly £50.
