# The Customs Duties (ECSC) (Quota and Other Reliefs) (Amendment) Order 1982

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1 of the Customs and Excise Duties (General Reliefs) Act 1979(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. The Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (ECSC) (Quota and Other Reliefs) (Amendment) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 15th October 1982.
- 2. From the coming into operation of this Order, Article 2 of the Customs Duties (ECSC) (Quota and Other Reliefs) Order 1981 (b) shall not apply to goods which fall within subheading 73.07 A.I. or 73.07 B.I. and which originate in Argentina.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends Article 2 of the Customs Duties (ECSC) (Quota and Other Reliefs) Order 1981, which provides for exemption from customs duty for certain iron and steel products so that it no longer applies to certain blooms, billets, slabs and sheet bars of iron and steel, originating in Argentina.
