# The Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Revocation (No. 4) Order 1982

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(1) as read with section 11 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, being satisfied as respects the area comprising the Marybank Fish Farm (but excluding the hatchery) owned by Kincardine Fisheries Ltd enclosed in a square between OS Grid References 757760, 759760, 757758 and 759758, that the waters therein are no longer infected waters, hereby makes the following order:—

### Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Revocation (No. 4) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 27th October 1982.

## Revocation of order

2. The Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) (No. 2) Order 1982(b) is hereby revoked.
