**1982 No. 1900 (S. 205)****RATING AND VALUATION****The Rating of Industry (Scotland) Order 1982***Approved by the House of Commons**Made - - - - 10th December 1982**Laid before the  
House of Commons 16th December 1982**Coming into Operation 9th February 1983*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 10(2) of the Local Government (Financial Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1963(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Rating of Industry (Scotland) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on the day following the day on which it is approved by resolution of the Commons House of Parliament.

2. In respect of the years 1983–84 and 1984–85, the rateable value of any industrial or freight transport lands and heritages so far as occupied and used or treated as occupied and used for industrial or freight transport purposes shall be the amount produced by deducting from the net annual value thereof fifty per cent of that value.
