EXHIBITION OF FILMS

The Films (Exhibitors) (Amendment) Regulations 1982

Made -11th March 1982 Coming into Operation 1st April 1982

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred by section 44 of the Films Act 1960(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Films (Exhibitors) (Amendment) Regulations 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1982.
- 2. Regulation 1 of the Films (Exhibitors) Regulations 1961(c) shall be further amended by substituting for paragraph (4) thereof the following paragraph-
 - "(4) The fee referred to in paragraph (3) of this Regulation shall be in the case of a licence to be issued:

(a)	for a calendar year	£ 47
(<i>b</i>)	for a quarterly period	£14
(c)	for 2 quarterly periods	£ 26
(<i>d</i>)	for 3 quarterly periods	£38"

3. The Films (Exhibitors) (Amendment) Regulations 1980(d) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations further amend the Films (Exhibitors) Regulations 1961 by increasing the fees payable in respect of applications for exhibitors' licences under the Films Act 1960; the increases are approximately 18%.
