REGISTRATION OF FILMS

The Films (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 1982

Made - - - 11th March 1982

Coming into Operation 1st April 1982

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred by section 44 of the Films Act 1960(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Films (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1982.

2. The Films (Registration) Regulations 1970(c) shall be further amended—

- (a) in Regulation 5(1) by substituting for the amounts “£40” and “£31” the amounts “£47” and “£37”, respectively;
- (b) in Regulation 5(2), by substituting for the amount “£20” the amount “£24”;
- (c) in Regulation 13, by substituting for the amount “£0.50” the amount “£0.60”;
- (d) in Regulation 14, by substituting for the amount “£2.50” the amount “£3.00”.

These Regulations further amend the Films (Registration) Regulations 1970 by increasing the fees in respect of applications for the registration under the Films Act 1960 of all films (other than co-production films) applications to amend the register, inspection of the register and applications for certified copies of entries in the register.
