**The Isle of Dogs Enterprise Zone Designation Order 1982**

Whereas by a resolution dated 2nd February 1982 the London Docklands Development Corporation adopted the Isle of Dogs Enterprise Zone Scheme;

And whereas an advertisement in accordance with the requirements of paragraph 3(7) and (8) of Schedule 32 to the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980(a) was published in the London Gazette, The Standard and the East London Advertiser relating to the Isle of Dogs Enterprise Zone;

And whereas six weeks have expired since the date of the first publication of the said advertisement (namely the publication in The Standard on 5th February 1982) and no application has been made to the High Court;

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 179 and paragraph 5 of Schedule 32 to the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Isle of Dogs Enterprise Zone Designation Order 1982 and shall come into operation on *26th April 1982*.

2. In this order “the deposited map” means the set of maps numbered 1 to 7 prepared in duplicate, marked “Map referred to in the Isle of Dogs Enterprise Zone Designation Order 1982”, and signed by an Under Secretary in the Department of the Environment, one duplicate of which has been deposited and is available for inspection at the principal offices of the London Docklands Development Corporation and the other duplicate of which has been deposited and is available for inspection at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment.

3. The area to which the Isle of Dogs Enterprise Zone Scheme relates and which is shown on the deposited map and marked accordingly is hereby designated as an enterprise zone.

4.— (1) The boundary of the enterprise zone is shown on the deposited map by a black line edged internally with a stippled band. The boundary is represented by the outside of the black line.

(2) The date when the designation order takes effect is the date of the coming into operation of this order.

(3) The period for which the area is to remain an enterprise zone is a period of ten years from the date when the designation takes effect.

(4) The London Docklands Development Corporation is hereby designated as the enterprise zone authority for the Isle of Dogs Enterprise Zone.

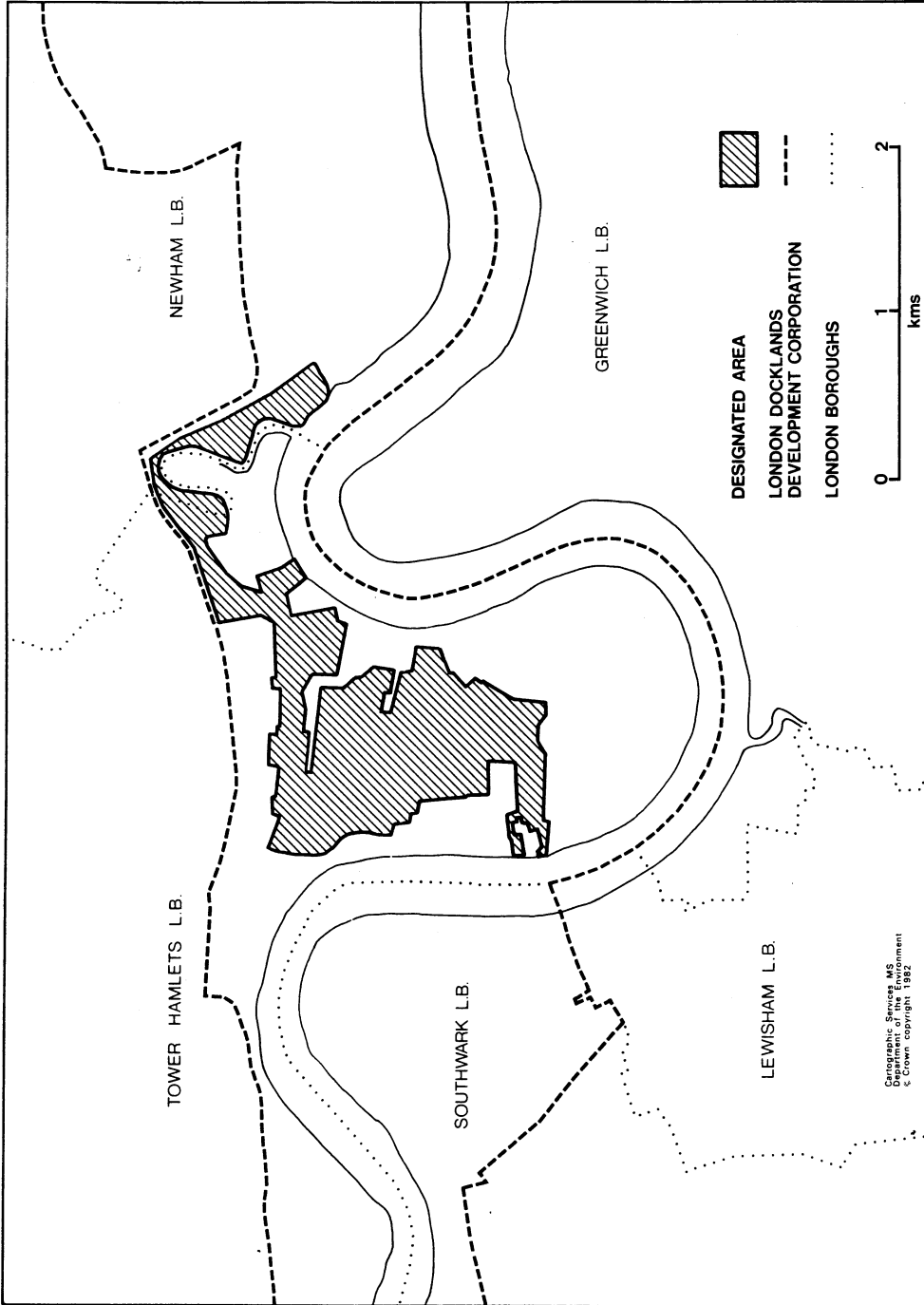
#### EXPLANATORY NOTE
