LAND REGISTRATION, SCOTLAND

**The Land Registration (Scotland) Act 1979 (Commencement No. 2)  
Order 1982**

*Made* - - - *1st April 1982*

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 30(2) of the Land Registration (Scotland) Act 1979(a) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and interpretation*

1. This order may be cited as the Land Registration (Scotland) Act 1979 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1982.

*Commencement*

2. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 2 and subsection (3) of section 3 of the Land Registration (Scotland) Act 1979 shall come into operation on 4th October 1982 in the area, for the purpose of registration of writs, of the County of Dunbarton.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order brings into force on 4 October 1982 in the area of the County of Dunbarton subsections (1) and (2) of Section 2 (which subsections provide for the circumstances in which an interest in land shall be registrable) and subsection (3) of Section 3 (which subsection provides that certain persons are to obtain a real right only by registration) of the Land Registration (Scotland) Act 1979.
