The Lord Chancellor and the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 365(3) of the Companies Act 1948(a) and section 2 of the Public Offices Fees Act 1879(b) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make, sanction and consent to the following Order:—
