The Gas (Meter) (Amendment) Regulations 1982

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 30(3) and (6)(d) and (e) of the Gas Act 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Gas (Meter) (Amendment) Regulations 1982 and shall come into operation on 14th May 1982.

2. The Gas (Meter) Regulations 1974(b) shall have effect subject to the following modifications—

- (a) in Regulation 6(2)(b), for the words “£8”, there shall be substituted the words “£8.88”;
- (b) in Regulation 6(3), for the words “33p.”, there shall be substituted the words “36p.”; and
- (c) in column 2 of Schedule 1 for the words “0.88”, “1.25”, “3.75”, “12.50” and “31.25” there shall be substituted respectively the words “0.97”, “1.38”, “4.16”, “13.87” and “34.68”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

The Gas (Meter) Regulations 1974 as amended have prescribed the fees to be paid to the Secretary of State for the examination or re-examination of meters by meter examiners. These Regulations substitute increased fees for those previously prescribed for the examination or re-examination of meters other than prototypes, the fees for which remain unaltered.
