**The Revocation of Instrument of Management  
(Greenacres School) Order 1982**

*Made* - - - - - 5th July 1982

*Coming into Operation* 27th July 1982

Whereas the Trustees of the Greenacres School have given not less than 2 years notice in writing to the Secretary of State and to the Wiltshire County Council of their intention to cease to provide the controlled community home known as Greenacres School as from 1st May 1984;

And whereas the body of managers of the aforesaid home have given notice in writing to the Secretary of State that they are unwilling to continue as managers of the home until the date specified in the first mentioned notices;

Now therefore the Secretary of State for Social Services in exercise of his powers under section 43(4) of the Child Care Act 1980(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Revocation of Instrument of Management (Greenacres School) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 27th July 1982.

*Revocation of Instrument of Management*

2. The Greenacres School Instrument of Management Order 1973 and the Greenacres School Instrument of Management (Variation) Order 1978 are hereby revoked.

*Conduct of the Home*

3. The Wiltshire County Council shall conduct the controlled community home known as Greenacres School and situate at Calne, Wiltshire until 12th August 1982 as if it were a community home provided by the aforesaid Council.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order revokes the Instrument of Management for the controlled community home known as the Greenacres School, Calne as from 27th July 1982 and makes provision for the Wiltshire County Council to run the home as if it were a Community home provided by the Council from that date until 12th August 1982.
