**The Safety of Sports Grounds (Designation)
(Scotland) Order 1983**

Made - - - - - 6th July 1983
Laid before Parliament 26th July 1983
Coming into Operation 1st January 1984

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1(1) of the Safety of Sports Grounds Act 1975(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and, as required by section 18(4) of that Act, after consultation with such persons or bodies of persons as appear to me requisite, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Safety of Sports Grounds (Designation) (Scotland) Order 1983 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1984.

2. The stadium in Scotland specified in the Schedule to this order, being a sports stadium which in the opinion of the Secretary of State has accommodation for more than 10,000 spectators, is hereby designated as a stadium requiring a safety certificate under the Safety of Sports Grounds Act 1975.

STADIUM IN SCOTLAND DESIGNATED AS REQUIRING A SAFETY CERTIFICATE
UNDER THE
SAFETY OF SPORTS GROUNDS ACT 1975

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order designates Muirton Park, Perth as a stadium which requires a safety certificate under the Safety of Sports Grounds Act 1975. Other sports stadia in Scotland which require safety certificates are designated under the Safety of Sports Grounds (Designation) (Scotland) Orders 1976 (S.I. 1976/1285), 1977 (S.I. 1977/1345) (as varied by the Safety of Sports Grounds (Designation) (Scotland) Variation Order 1982 (S.I. 1982/60)), 1978 (S.I. 1978/1099), 1979 (S.I. 1979/1026), and 1980 (S.I. 1980/1034).
