(Mental Health Act Commission) Order 1983**

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 27th day of July 1983

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

Her Majesty, in pursuance of section 109(d) of the National Health Service Act 1977(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Health Service Commissioner for England (Mental Health Act Commission) Order 1983 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1983.

Designation as body subject to investigation

2. The Mental Health Act Commission is hereby designated as an authority to which section 109 of the National Health Service Act 1977 (bodies subject to investigation by Health Service Commissioner) applies.
