POLICE

The Police (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1983

Made 2nd September 1983 Laid before Parliament 7th September 1983 Coming into Operation 28th September 1983

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 26 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after taking into consideration the recommendations made by the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom and furnishing the said Board with a draft of the regulations in accordance with section 2(1) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(b), I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1983.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Police (Scotland) Regulations 1976(c).

Operation and effect

- 3. These regulations shall come into operation on 28th September 1983 and shall have effect—
 - (a) for the purposes of regulation 4, as from 1st January 1983;
 - (b) for the purposes of regulations 5, 6, 7 and of the Schedule to these regulations, as from 1st September 1983.

Amendments

4. In paragraphs 2(3) and 2(6) of Schedule 5 to the principal regulations (Motor vehicle allowances in respect of motor cars) for the figure "9,000" there shall be substituted the figure "11,000".

- 5. In Schedule 3 to the principal regulations (Scales of pay) for Tables A and B there shall be substituted, respectively, Tables A and B set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- **6.** In paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 10 to the principal regulations (Dog handler's allowance), for the sums "£432" and "£585" there shall be substituted respectively the sums "£468" and "£633".

Revocations

7. Regulations 8 and 9 of the Police (Scotland) Amendment (No. 3) Regulations 1982(a) (relating respectively to scales of pay and to dog handler's allowance) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations further amend the Police (Scotland) Regulations 1976 ("the principal regulations").

Regulation 4 amends paragraphs 2(3) and 2(6) of Schedule 5 to the principal regulations by increasing from 9,000 to 11,000 miles the mileage figure in respect of which the basic rate per mile of motor vehicle allowance for an essential user is applied.

Regulation 5 increases the rates of pay for police constables up to and including the rank of chief inspector.

Regulation 6 increases the amount of dog handlers' allowances from £432 to £468 and from £585 to £633.

Regulation 4 has effect from 1st January 1983. Regulations 5, 6 and 7 have effect from 1st September 1983.

The retrospective effect of the regulations is authorised by section 26(3) of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967.
