- 1. This Order may be cited as the Hallmarking (International Convention) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1983 and shall come into operation on 8th November 1983.
- 2. Schedule 2 to the Hallmarking (International Convention) Order 1976(b) is hereby further amended by inserting, after the entry for Finland, the following entry:—
