**The Fire Services (Compensation) (Scotland)  
Amendment Regulations 1983**

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	15th February 1983
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	10th March 1983
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	31st March 1983

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 219 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Fire Services (Compensation) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1983 and shall come into operation on 31st March 1983.

*Interpretation*

2. In these regulations, “the principal regulations” means the Fire Services (Compensation) (Scotland) Regulations 1975(b).

*Amendment of the principal regulations*

3. In regulation 2(1) of the principal regulations in sub-paragraph (b) of the definition of “material date”, after the words “under the Act” there shall be inserted the words “on or before 31 March 1983”.

4. In regulation 4(1) of the principal regulations after the words “under the Act” there shall be inserted the words “in force on 31 March 1983”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

The Fire Services (Compensation) (Scotland) Regulations 1975 provide that compensation shall be payable where a loss of employment or loss or diminution of emoluments occurs as a consequence of the provisions of an instrument made under the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973. These Regulations amend the principal Regulations so that those Regulations shall not apply where the loss occurs as a result of any provisions coming into force after 31 March 1983.
