## MERCHANT SHIPPING

**The Merchant Shipping Act 1979 (Commencement No. 7) Order  
1983**

Made - - - - - 18th March 1983

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred on him by section 52(2) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1979 (a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping Act 1979 (Commencement No. 7) Order 1983.
2. The provisions of the Act specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order (which relate to the matters specified in the second column of that Schedule) shall come into force on 3rd May 1983.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order brings into force on 3rd May 1983 section 31 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1979. Section 31(1) substitutes a new subsection for section 85(3) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1894 which will enable the Secretary of State to make regulations as to how, when, where and by whom deck cargo space is to be measured for tonnage purposes, for penalties for contravening such regulations and for related matters. Section 31(2) makes consequential amendments in section 1(2)(c) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1965. Consequential repeals in the 1965 Act are also brought into operation.
