**The Health and Safety (Miscellaneous Fees for Approvals)
Regulations 1983**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	25th January 1983
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	3rd February 1983
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	7th March 1983

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 43(2), (4), (5) and (6) and 82(3)(a) of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974(a) (“the 1974 Act”) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and for the purpose of giving effect without modifications to proposals submitted to him by the Health and Safety Commission under section 11(2)(d) of the 1974 Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health and Safety (Miscellaneous Fees for Approvals) Regulations 1983 and shall come into operation on 7th March 1983.

(2) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—

“approval” includes the amendment of an approval and “amendment of an approval” includes the issue of a new approval replacing the original and incorporating an amendment;

“respiratory protective equipment” includes any respirator and any breathing apparatus.

Fees payable in respect of applications for approvals

2.—(1) A fee shall be payable to the Health and Safety Executive on application being made to the Executive or to an inspector for an approval under—

- (a) the Factories Act 1961(b) or any regulation or order made, or having effect as if made, under that Act;
- (b) the Agriculture (Tractor Cabs) Regulations 1974(c);

(c) the Health and Safety (Agriculture) (Poisonous Substances) Regulations 1975(a);

(d) the Control of Lead at Work Regulations 1980(b);

where the subject matter of the approval is specified in column 1 of the Schedule to these Regulations and the fee shall be that specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the relevant Part of the Schedule.

(2) A further fee shall be payable to the Executive in the case of an application for an approval specified in column 1 of Part I of the Schedule if the Executive certifies that the work involved in determining whether to grant the approval exceeded 6 man-hours; and that further fee shall be determined at the hourly rate specified in column 3 of Part I in respect of that application for each man-hour certified by the Executive as being in excess of the first 6; but it shall not become payable until after the Executive has given a copy of the certificate to the applicant or has sent it to him by post.

(3) For the purpose of these Regulations, in calculating the number of man-hours involved in any case, no account shall be taken of any typing, messenger or other ancillary work (for which no further charge shall be payable).

Part I

Approvals of respiratory protective equipment under the Factories Act 1961 or regulations made or having effect as if made under that Act or the Control of Lead at Work Regulations 1980, and approvals of other plant and equipment under the Factories Act 1961 or regulations made or having effect as if made under that Act.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations provide for the fixing and determination of fees to be payable to the Health and Safety Executive in respect of approvals the subject matter of which is specified in the Schedule.

The amount of the fee is the sum specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the relevant part of the Schedule.

In respect of those approvals specified in Part I of the Schedule a further fee is payable to the Executive where the amount of work involved in determining whether to grant that approval exceeds 6 man-hours. That further fee is to be determined at the hourly rate specified in column 3 of that part of the Schedule.
