CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS

Amendment of the Social Security Benefit (Persons Abroad) Regulations 1975

16. In regulation 2(1) of the Social Security Benefit (Persons Abroad) Regulations 1975⁽¹⁾ (modification of the Act in relation to various benefits) for the shoulder note and the words in that regulation down to and including “non-contributory invalidity pension”, there shall be substituted the following shoulder note and words:—

“Modification of the Act in relation to sickness benefit, invalidity benefit, severe disablement allowance, unemployability supplement and maternity allowance

2.—(1) A person shall not be disqualified for receiving sickness benefit, invalidity benefit, severe disablement allowance”.
