The Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980 (Commencement No. 9) Order 1984

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 94(2) of the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980 (Commencement No. 9) Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 24th October 1984.
- 2. Part X of the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980 shall come into operation on 24th October 1984 in the areas of the district councils in Wales in which the said Part X is not already in operation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order brings Part X of the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980 into operation in those areas of Wales in which it is not already in operation. The areas in which it is already in operation are specified in the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980 (Commencement No. 8) Order 1983 (S.I. 1983/94). These comprise the areas of the district councils of Alyn and Deeside, Cardiff, Newport, Swansea, the Vale of Glamorgan and Wrexham Maelor. Part X of the Act provides for registers to be kept of land owned by public bodies, being land which, in the opinion of the Secretary of State, is not being used or not being sufficiently used for the performance of a public body's functions or of carrying on their undertaking. Part X also provides that the Secretary of State may direct a public body who own land on a register to take steps to dispose of it.

This order brings into force in England and Wales all the provisions of the Local Government Planning and Land Act 1980 not previously brought into force.
