The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, being Ministers designated^(a) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972^(b) in relation to the common agricultural policy of the European Economic Community, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred on them by that section and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

Title and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Produce Quotas (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1984 and shall come into operation on 20th November 1984.

Amendment of previous regulations

2. Paragraph 1 of Schedule 5 to the Dairy Produce Quotas Regulations 1984^(c) (which limits the number of members of the Dairy Produce Quota Tribunals for England and Wales and for Northern Ireland) shall be further amended by the substitution of “ninety” for “thirty”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations further amend the Dairy Produce Quotas Regulations 1984 by increasing the maximum number of members of the Dairy Produce Quota Tribunals for England and Wales and for Northern Ireland from 30 to 90.

The Dairy Produce Quotas Regulations 1984 implement regulations of the European Community setting up a quota system for dairy produce. The Dairy Produce Quota Tribunals are bodies set up to consider applications from producers to be treated as special cases and awarded additional quota.
