EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order transfers to the Chancellor of the Duchy of Lancaster functions presently exercised by the Lord President of the Council—

- (a) under specified enactments relating to the arts, to libraries and museums and to the national heritage (Article 2(1) and Part I of Schedule 1);
- (b) in relation to the following institutions, namely, the Arts Council of Great Britain, the British Film Institute, the Corporation of the Hall of Arts and Sciences, the Crafts Council, the National Film and Television School, the National Theatre Board, the Science Museum, the South Bank Theatre Board and the Victoria and Albert Museum (Article 2(2) and Part II of Schedule 1); and
- (c) under a deed relating to the development of land adjacent to the Royal Opera House, Covent Garden (Article 2(3)).
