The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Nursing and Midwifery Qualifications (EEC Recognition) Amendment Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 29th January 1985.

*Amendment of section 11(3A) of the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979*

2. In section 11(3A) of the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979(b) (inserted by Article 3 of the Nursing and Midwifery Qualifications (EEC Recognition) Order 1983(c)) there shall be inserted after the words "prescribed conditions" the words "required by a directive issued by the Council of the European Communities".
