**ANCIENT MONUMENTS**

**The Ancient Monuments (Class Consents) (Amendment)  
Order 1984**

*Made* - - - 28th February 1984  
*Laid before Parliament* 8th March 1984  
*Coming into Operation* 1st April 1984

The Secretary of State, after consultation with the Historic Buildings and Monuments Commission for England, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3 of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Ancient Monuments (Class Consents) (Amendment) Order 1984, and shall come into operation on 1st April 1984.
2. The Ancient Monuments (Class Consents) Order 1981(b) shall be amended by adding at the end of the Schedule —

“Class VI Works executed by the Historic Buildings and Monuments Commission for England.”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This order amends the Ancient Monuments (Class Consents) order 1981. The 1981 order, which applies only to England and Wales, grants consent under Part I of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979 for the execution of certain specified classes or descriptions of works affecting scheduled monuments.

This order adds works executed by the Historic Buildings and Monuments Commission for England which was established by the National Heritage Act 1983 (c.47).
