The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 123 (1), (2) and (3) of the Patents Act 1977(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and with the consent of the Treasury pursuant to subsection (4) of the said section 123, hereby makes the following Rules:—

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Patents (Amendment) Rules 1984 and shall come into operation as respect rules 1 and 3 on 2nd April 1984 and as respects rule 2 on 6th June 1984.
- 2.—(1) There shall be substituted as Schedule 1 to the Patents Rules 1982(b) the Schedule hereto.
- (2) Rules 2 and 3 of the Patents (Amendment) Rules 1983(c) are hereby revoked.
- 3. Where on or after 2nd April 1984 but before 6th June 1984 an application is made for renewal of a patent in respect of any year beginning on or after 6th June 1984, the fee payable on such application shall be that which would be payable if the application were made on or after 6th June 1984 and rule 2 of these Rules had come into operation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules amend the Patents Rules 1982 so as to abolish the fees formerly corresponding to Patents Forms 27 and 28 in Part B of Schedule 1 to those Rules, and increase other fees. The new fees are payable on or after 6th June 1984 except in the case of certain renewal fees paid in advance. Fees payable for the renewal of a patent in respect of any year beginning on or after 6th June 1984 are increased on 2nd April 1984.

It is estimated that the total amount of fees collected per annum at the new levels will be 4.8 per cent greater than the amount collected per annum at the existing levels.
