ROAD TRAFFIC

The Goods Vehicles (Plating and Testing) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1984

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 45 of the Road Traffic Act 1972 (a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st May 1984, and may be cited as the Goods Vehicles (Plating and Testing) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1984.

2. The Goods Vehicles (Plating and Testing) Regulations 1982 (c) are hereby amended so that in the Regulations specified in column 1 of the Table below for the words specified in column 2 of that Table there are substituted the words specified in column 3 of that Table.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Goods Vehicles (Plating and Testing) Regulations 1982 so that:—

- (i) the fee payable on an application for a first examination or periodical test is increased from £21 to £23 in the case of a motor vehicle and from £11 to £12.50 in the case of a trailer;
- (ii) the fee for a re-test or further re-test within 14 days after the first examination or earlier re-test and at the same station or at another auxilliary station by arrangement is increased from £10 to £11.50 in the case of a motor vehicle and from £6 to £6.50 in the case of a trailer, and the fee for re-tests in other circumstances is increased from £21 to £23 in the case of a motor vehicle and from £11 to £12.50 in the case of a trailer;
- (iii) the fee payable on a request for an amendment to a plating certificate following a notifiable alteration is increased from £8.50 to £9.50; and
- (iv) the fee payable on an application for a replacement for a lost or defaced plate, certificate or disc is increased from £1.50 to £7.
