**The Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982
(Commencement) Amendment Order 1984**

Made - - - - 10th April 1984

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 137(2) of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (Commencement) Amendment Order 1984.

(2) In this order the “principal order” means the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (Commencement) Order 1983(b).

2. In article 2 of the principal order, there shall be substituted—

(a) for the words “the Schedule” where they first occur, the words “Schedule 1”; and

(b) for the words “the Schedule” where they occur for the second time, the words “that Schedule”.

3. After article 2 of the principal order, there shall be inserted the following article:—

“2A. The provisions of the Act, which are specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this order, shall, subject to any restrictions in the application specified in column 2 of that Schedule, come into operation on 18th April 1984.”.

4. The Schedule, and the Appendix to the Schedule, to the principal order shall be retitled “Schedule 1” and “Appendix to Schedule 1”.

5. After the Appendix to Schedule 1 to the principal order, as retitled, there shall be inserted the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this order.

PROVISIONS COMING INTO EFFECT ON 18TH APRIL 1984

<i>Provisions of the Act.</i> Section 119	<i>Restrictions in application</i> Only to the extent necessary to enable, in accordance with the provisions of this section:— (a) any application for permission to organise a public charitable collection on or after 1st July 1984 to be made and considered; (b) any permission in respect of such a collection to be granted, refused, varied or withdrawn; (c) any appeal to the sheriff to be made, considered and dealt with; (d) any direction by the Secretary of State under sub-section (11) or (12) to be made, revoked or amended; and (e) any regulations to be made by the Secretary of State under sub-section (13) in relation to such collections.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (Commencement) Order 1983 (“the principal order”).

The principal order provided, amongst other things, that section 119 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, which makes provision for the regulation of public charitable collections, should come into operation on 1st July 1984.

This order amends the principal order by bringing section 119 of that Act into operation on 18th April 1984 but only to the extent necessary for the purpose of enabling preliminary arrangements to be made for that section to be fully effective in operation as from 1st July 1984, including enabling applications for permission to organise a public charitable collection on or after 1st July 1984 to be made and considered.
