The Motor Vehicles (Tests) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1984

Made	23rd May 1984
Laid before Parliament	4th June 1984
Coming into Operation	1st July 1984

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 43(2) and (6) of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st July 1984, and may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Tests) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1984.
- 2. The Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1981(c) are hereby amended so that in the Regulations specified in column 1 of the Table below for the words specified in column 2 of that Table there are substituted the words specified in column 3 of that Table.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1981 so that:—

- (i) the fee payable for the examination of a motor cycle not having a side car attached to it is increased from £5.40 to £6; and
- (ii) the fee payable for the examination of any other vehicle (not being a vehicle in Class VI) is increased from £9.00 to £10.
