DEER

The Deer (Close Seasons) (Scotland) Order 1984

Made - - - 20th January 1984

Laid before Parliament 8th February 1984

Coming into Operation 1st May 1984

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 21(2) of the Deer (Scotland) Act 1959(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with such organisations as appear to me to represent persons likely to be affected by this Order, I hereby make the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Deer (Close Seasons) (Scotland) Order 1984, and shall come into operation on 1st May 1984.

Close Seasons for certain species of deer

2. Subject to the provisions of section 33 of the Deer (Scotland) Act 1959(a), no person shall take or wilfully kill or injure any deer of any of the species mentioned in the Schedule to this Order during the periods hereby fixed in each year and specified in the said Schedule in relation respectively to male and female deer of any such species.

Revocation

3. The Deer (Close Seasons) (Scotland) Order 1966(b) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit the killing, taking or injuring of certain species of deer (other than red deer for which a close season is specified in section 21(1) of the Deer (Scotland) Act 1959) during the periods fixed by the Order except in the circumstances set out in section 33 of that Act (which relates to acts done for the prevention of suffering or to prevent serious damage by deer to crops, pasture, trees or human or animal foodstuffs).
