**The Telecommunications Act 1984 (Nominated  
Company) Order 1984**

Made - - - - 27th June 1984

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 60(3) and 104(1) of the Telecommunications Act 1984<sup>(a)</sup> and after consulting British Telecommunications, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Telecommunications Act 1984 (Nominated Company) Order 1984.

2. The company nominated for the purposes of section 60 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 is British Telecommunications public limited company (registered number 1800000).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

Section 60(1) of the Telecommunications Act 1984 provides that, on a day appointed by the Secretary of State, all the property, rights and liabilities (other than the excepted liabilities) to which British Telecommunications was entitled or subject immediately before that date shall (subject to certain provisions of the 1984 Act) become by virtue of that section property, rights and liabilities of a company nominated for the purposes of the section by the Secretary of State.

This Order provides that the nominated company is British Telecommunications plc.
