# The Sea Fishing (Specified Western Waters) (Restrictions on Landing) (Variation) Order 1984

Made - - - - 1st February 1984
Laid before Parliament 1st February 1984
Coming into Operation 2nd February 1984

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with the sea fishing industry in Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 6(1) and 20(1) of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consultation with the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry, hereby make the following order:—

#### Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Sea Fishing (Specified Western Waters) (Restrictions on Landing) (Variation) Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 2nd February 1984.

Variation of the Sea Fishing (Specified Western Waters) (Restrictions on Landing) Order 1980

- 2. The Sea Fishing (Specified Western Waters) (Restrictions on Landing) Order 1980(b) is hereby varied—
  - (a) by substituting in article 4(b) thereof for the words "40 feet" the words "10 metres";
  - (b) by substituting in Schedule 2 thereto for the name "monkfish" the name "anglerfish".

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This order replaces the Sea Fishing (Specified Western Waters) (Restrictions on Landing) (Variation No. 2) Order 1983, which was in the same terms but which included an inaccurate statement in respect of consultation required to be carried out pursuant to section 6(1) of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967.

This order further varies the Sea Fishing (Specified Western Waters) (Restrictions on Landing) Order 1980, which prohibits the landing in the United Kingdom of specified species of sea fish which have not been caught under the authority of a licence. One of the exceptions to the prohibition is the landing of fish caught by British fishing boats whose length is less than 40 feet; this order reduces the length below which the prohibition does not apply to 10 metres. This order also substitutes in Schedule 2 for the name "monkfish" (which is sometimes used for *Lophius* spp) the more appropriate name "anglerfish".
