1984 No. 98**ROAD TRAFFIC****The Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 1984**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 119, 120(1) and 124 of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These regulations shall come into operation on 12th March 1984 and may be cited as the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 1984.

2. The Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1977(c) shall be further amended in accordance with the following provisions of these Regulations.

3. For Regulation 8 substitute the following Regulation:—

“Fees for licences

8.—(1) The fee for the grant of a provisional licence is £2.50.

(2) The fee for the grant of a full licence is —

(a) £5 if the application for the licence is received by the licensing authority before 1st May 1984; and

(b) £5.50 if the application for the licence is received by the licensing authority on or after 1st May 1984.”.

4. For Regulation 23 substitute the following Regulation:—

“Fees for tests

23. The fee payable by a person who applies for a test to be conducted by an examiner appointed under Regulation 18(1)(a) is —

- (a) £59.50 if the application is received by the clerk mentioned in Regulation 16(1) before 12th March 1984; and
- (b) £65 if the application is received by that clerk on or after 12th March 1984.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1977 by increasing the fee for a full licence from £5 to £5.50 and the fee payable by a person who applies for a test from £59.50 to £65. The increase in the fee for a full licence will take effect where applications are received on or after 1st May 1984. The increase in the fee payable by a person who applies for a test will take effect where applications are received on or after 12th March 1984.
