The Savings Certificates (Yearly Plan) (Amendment) Regulations 1985

Made	8th July 1985
Laid before Parliament	8th July 1985
Coming into Operation	10th July 1985

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11(1) and (3) of the National Debt Act 1972(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Savings Certificates (Yearly Plan) (Amendment) Regulations 1985, and shall come into operation on 10th July 1985.
- 2. The Savings Certificates (Yearly Plan) Regulations 1984(b) shall be amended as follows:-
 - (1) in Regulation 2—
 - (a) in the definition of "mentally disordered person" by substituting for the words "Mental Health Act 1959"(c) the words "Mental Health Act 1983"(d), and
 - (b) in the definition of "receiver" by substituting for the words "Part VIII of the Mental Health Act 1959" the words "Part VII of the Mental Health Act 1983"; and
 - (2) in Regulation 5(1) and (2) by substituting for the words "£100" the words "£200".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Savings Certificates (Yearly Plan) Regulations 1984 by increasing from £100 to £200 per month the maximum payment which may be made by or on behalf of any one person under agreements subject to the Regulations.

They also substitute a reference to the Mental Health Act 1983 for the reference to the Mental Health Act 1959 in the definitions of "mentally disordered person" and "receiver".
