# The Pensioners' Lump Sum Payments Order 1985

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made - - - - 29th July 1985 Coming into Operation 2nd December 1985

Whereas a draft of this order was laid before Parliament in accordance with the provisions of section 4(1)(a) of the Pensioners' Payments and Social Security Act 1979(a) and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4(1) and (2) of the Pensioners' Payments and Social Security Act 1979 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.— (1) This order may be cited as the Pensioners' Lump Sum Payments Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 2nd December 1985.
- (2) In this order "the Act" means the Pensioners' Payments and Social Security Act 1979.

Substitution in the Act for references to the relevant week and to the passing of the Act

- 2. Sections 1 to 3 of the Act shall have effect as if—
  - (a) for references to the relevant week there were substituted references to the week beginning 2nd December 1985; and
  - (b) for references to the passing of the Act there were substituted references to the making of this order.
