EDUCATION, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1985

Made - - - - 2nd August 1985
Coming into Operation 16th August 1985

WHEREAS

- (1) in pursuance of section 2(2) of the Remuneration of Teachers Act 1965(a) ("the Act") the Committee constituted under section 1 of the Act for the purpose of considering the remuneration of teachers paid by local education authorities who are employed in establishments of further education and to other teachers employed by such authorities for the purpose of their functions relating to further education (excluding teachers seconded to bodies which reimburse the employing authorities the amount of their salaries) ("the Committee") have transmitted to the Secretary of State for Education and Science ("the Secretary of State") recommendations agreed on by them with respect to the remuneration of such teachers ("further education teachers");
- (2) there are in force Orders made under section 2(4) and (6) of the Act with respect to the remuneration of the teachers in question, namely, the Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) Order 1983(b), the Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) (Amendment) Order 1984(c) and the Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) (Amendment) Order 1985(d);
- (3) it appears to the Secretary of State that effect can most conveniently be given to the recommendations of the Committee by further amending the provisions set out in the document referred to in the said Orders, namely the document published by Her Majesty's Stationery Office on the 7th October 1983 under the title "Scales of Salaries for Teachers in Further Education, England and Wales 1983" (e) ("the 1983 Document"), as amended by the said Orders of 1984 and 1985;
- (4) in pursuance of section 2(5) of the Act, the Secretary of State has prepared a draft Order setting out the amendments to the 1983 Document which, in his opinion, are requisite for giving effect to the recommendations of the Committee; and
- (5) the Secretary of State, as required by section 2(6) of the Act, has consulted the Committee with respect to the draft Order and the Committee have made no representations with respect thereto:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in pursuance of sections 2(6) and 7(3) of the Act, hereby makes the following Order, which is in the form of the draft:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1985.
- (2) This Order shall come into operation on 16th August 1985 and shall have effect as from the 1st April 1984.
- 2. In section 11 of the 1983 Document (London Area Allowances), for the sum of £258 mentioned in sub-paragraph (2)(d) there shall be substituted the sum of £264.
 - 3. In paragraph 1 of Annex B to Appendix III to the 1983 Document(a)—
 - (a) there shall be added after sub-paragraph (i) the following sub-paragraph—
 - "(ia) A course at an institution within the United Kingdom approved by the Secretary of State for the purposes of paragraph 2(b)(i) of Schedule 5 to the said Regulations as being comparable to a course of the kind described in paragraph 2(a) of the said Schedule 5.";
 - (b) for sub-paragraph (ii) there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph—
 - "(ii) A course leading to the Certificate in Education (Further Education) awarded by a university in the United Kingdom or validated by the Council for National Academic Awards.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends, with effect from the 1st April 1984, provisions contained in the Document setting out the scales and other provisions for determining the remuneration of teachers employed in further education establishments who are paid by local education authorities and of further education teachers employed by such authorities. This Document, entitled "Scales of Salaries for Teachers in Further Education, England and Wales 1983", which was amended by the Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) (Amendment) Orders 1984 and 1985, may be obtained from Government Bookshops or through booksellers.

The Order gives effect to recommendations made by the appropriate Burnham Committee under section 2 of the Remuneration of Teachers Act 1965. The amendments increase the London Area Allowances payable to teachers in the Fringe Area, as defined in section 11 of the Document, and add to the list of courses in Annex III to Appendix B to the Document which entitle certain lecturers to receive an increment on the appropriate salary scale.

The retrospective effect of the Order is authorised by section 7(3) of the Remuneration of Teachers Act 1965.
