**The Roads (Scotland) Act 1970 (Local Enactments) Revocation
Order 1985**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 143(1) and 154(3) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Roads (Scotland) Act 1970 (Local Enactments) Revocation Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 23rd October 1985.

2. The Roads (Scotland) Act 1970 (Local Enactments) Order 1971(b) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order revokes the Roads (Scotland) Act 1970 (Local Enactments) Order 1971. The statute under which that order was made has been repealed by the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984. The 1971 Order, which excepted certain local enactments from the provisions of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1970 (c. 20), is no longer required in the light of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 which provides for the matters covered by the excepted enactments.
