PUBLIC PASSENGER VEHICLES

The Darlington (Revocation of Restriction) Order 1985

Made - - - 23rd September 1985

Whereas Darlington Borough Council, being a person affected by the restriction imposed by sections 24 and 25 of the Darlington Corporation (Transport etc.) Act 1925(**a**), has applied to the Secretary of State for Transport that the said restriction be revoked:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 78 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Darlington (Revocation of Restriction) Order 1985.

2. The restriction imposed by sections 24 and 25 of the Darlington Corporation (Transport etc.) Act 1925 is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Sections 24 and 25 of the Darlington Corporation (Transport etc.) Act 1925 limit vehicles of Darlington Borough Council to a distance of one mile from the nearest point on the boundary without the consent of the United Automobile Services Limited and without the consent of the London and North Eastern Railway Company. This Order removes the restriction imposed by the said provisions.
