**The Police (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations 1985**

*Made* - - - 13th October 1985

*Laid before Parliament* 25th October 1985

*Coming into Operation* 18th November 1985

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 33 of the Police Act 1964(a), and after taking into account the recommendations made by the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom and furnishing the said Board with a draft of the Regulations in accordance with section 2(1) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(b), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations 1985.

2. These Regulations shall come into operation on 18th November 1985 and shall have effect, for the purposes of Regulations 5 and 6, as from 1st September 1985.

3. In these Regulations any reference to the principal Regulations is a reference to the Police Regulations 1979(c).

4. Regulation 28 of the principal Regulations shall be amended as follows:—

(a) in paragraph (3), for the words “3 months” there shall be substituted the words “12 months in the case of a superintendent or 3 months in any other case”;

(b) in paragraph (4), for the words “three months” there shall be substituted the words “12 months”.

5. Schedule 5 to the principal Regulations (scales of pay) shall be amended as follows:—

(a) for Tables A and B there shall be substituted respectively the Tables set out in the Appendix to these Regulations;

(b) 1980 c.10.

(c) S.I. 1979/1470; the relevant amending instrument is S.I. 1984/1808.

(b) in paragraph 1, after sub-paragraph (3), there shall be inserted the following provisions:—

“(3A) Where a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force holding the rank of chief superintendent has held that rank or the rank of superintendent in one or other of those forces at all times since 1st September 1985, his annual pay determined in accordance with Table A shall be increased by £474.

(3B) Where a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force holding the rank of superintendent has held that rank in one or other of those forces at all times since 1st September 1985, his annual pay determined in accordance with Table A shall be increased —

- (a) where he has, or is to be treated as having, more than two years' reckonable service in that rank, by £474;
- (b) where he has, or is to be treated as having more than one but less than two years' such service, by £624; and
- (c) in any other case, by £855.”.

6. In Schedule 11 to the principal Regulations (dog handler's allowance), there shall be substituted, in paragraph 1(a), for the words “£492” the words “£528”, and, in paragraph 1(b), for the words “£666” the words “£717”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations amend the Police Regulations 1979, with effect, as provided in Regulation 2, in the case of Regulations 5 and 6, as from 1st September 1985 (retrospection is authorised by section 33(4) of the Police Act 1964).

Regulation 4 amends the provision made by Regulation 28 of the 1979 Regulations for compensation where a superintendent or chief superintendent is required to do duty on a public holiday or has been prevented by the exigencies of duty from taking his monthly leave days in full. The Regulation extends from 3 months to 12 months the period within which he is entitled, subject to the exigencies of duty, to a day's leave in lieu or, as the case may be, additional leave days.

Regulation 5 increases scales of pay and includes additional provision for chief superintendents and superintendents in the City of London and metropolitan police forces holding those ranks on 1st September 1985. Regulation 6 increases the dog handler's allowance.
