## The A12 Trunk Road (Colchester Road, Havering) (Prohibition of Use of Gap in Central Reservation) Order 1985

Made - - - -

28th October 1985

Coming into Operation

1st November 1985

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Secretary of State for the Home Department, hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Colchester Road, Havering) (Prohibition of Use of Gap in Central Reservation) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1985.
  - 2. In this Order—

"Colchester Road" means that length of the London-Great Yarmouth Trunk Road (A12) in the London Borough of Havering known as Colchester Road; and

"central reservation" means that part of Colchester Road which separates the two carriageways of Colchester Road for the safety and guidance of vehicles using that road.

3. Save as provided in article 4 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gap in the central reservation which lies opposite Bampton Road, otherwise than from the westbound carriageway of Colchester Road.

4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes, or to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
