The Extradition (Hijacking) (Amendment) Order 1985

Made	18th December 1985

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 18th day of December 1985 Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by sections 2, 17 and 21 of the Extradition Act 1870(a) and sections 9(2) and 39(1) of the Aviation Security Act 1982(b), or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:---

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Extradition (Hijacking) (Amendment) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1986.
- 2. The Extradition (Hijacking) Order 1971(c) shall be amended by adding to Schedule 2 (which names the foreign States with which the United Kingdom has extradition treaties in force and which are parties to the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Seizure of Aircraft signed at The Hague on 16th December 1970(d)) the following entries:—

Monaco	17th December 1891	3rd July 1983

The Extradition (Hijacking) Order 1971 shall be amended by adding to Part I of Schedule 3 (which names the foreign States with which the United Kingdom has no extradition treaties in force and which are parties to the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Seizure of Aircraft signed at The Hague on 16th December 1970) the following entries:—
