**The Borough of Hinckley and Bosworth
(Electoral Arrangements) Order 1985**

Made - - - - - 19th January 1985
Coming into Operation 20th February 1985

Whereas in pursuance of a resolution of 18th October 1983 the Council of the Borough of Hinckley and Bosworth have, under section 7(4)(a) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), requested me to provide for a system of whole council elections to the Council:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by sections 7(6) and 67 of that Act, I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Hinckley and Bosworth (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1985 and shall come into operation one month after the day on which it is made.

2.—(1) The ordinary elections of councillors for all the wards of the Borough shall take place simultaneously in 1987 and every fourth year thereafter.

(2) All the councillors of the Borough shall retire together in 1987 on the fourth day after the ordinary day of election and the newly elected councillors shall come into office on the day on which their predecessors retire.

3.—(1) The ordinary elections of parish councillors for any parish or ward of a parish situated in the Barlestone, Nailstone and Osbaston, Ratby and Sheepy and Witherley wards of the Borough due to take place in 1986 shall take place instead in 1987 and every fourth year thereafter.

(2) The ordinary elections of parish councillors for any parish or ward of a parish situated in the Cadeby, Carlton and Market Bosworth, Newbold Verdon and Twycross and Shackerstone wards of the Borough due to take place in 1988 shall take place instead in 1987 and every fourth year thereafter.

(3) The parish councillors to whom the foregoing paragraphs apply shall retire on the fourth day after the ordinary day of election of parish councillors in 1987 and the newly elected councillors shall come into office on the day on which their predecessors retire.
