The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 40 of the Registered Designs Act 1949 (a) and now vested in him (b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after consultation with the Council on Tribunals pursuant to section 10(1) of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971 (c) and with the consent of the Treasury pursuant to the said section 40, hereby makes the following Rules:—

- 1 These Rules may be cited as the Designs (Amendment) Rules 1985 and shall come into operation as respects rules 1 and 3 on 17th June 1985 and as respects rule 2 on 8th July 1985.
- 2. There shall be substituted as Schedule 1 to the Designs Rules 1984 (d) the Schedule hereto.
- 3. Where on or after 17th June 1985 but before 8th July 1985 an application is made for an extension of the period of copyright in any registered design in respect of which the period of copyright current is due to expire on or after 8th July 1985, the fee payable on such application shall be that which would be payable if the application were made on or after 8th July 1985 and rule 2 of these Rules had come into operation.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules amend the Designs Rules 1984 so as to increase certain fees payable under them with effect from 8th July 1985, except in the case of fees paid in advance for the extension of the period of copyright in a design for any period beginning on or after 8th July 1985, which are increased with effect from 17th June 1985.

It is estimated that the total amount of fees collected per annum at the new levels will be six per cent greater than the amount collected per annum at the existing levels.
