- 1. This order may be cited as the Assured Tenancies (Approved Bodies) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 11th August 1986.
- **2.** The Assured Tenancies (Approved Bodies) (No. 4) Order 1982 is hereby amended by the omission from the list set out in the Schedule thereto of the following entry:
 - "5. Watkin, Starbuck & Jones Limited.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 56 of the Housing Act 1980 deals with assured tenancies. Such tenancies are subject to Part II of the Landlord and Tenant Act 1954 (c. 56), as modified by Schedule 5 to the 1980 Act, if they would otherwise have been protected tenancies or housing association tenancies under the Rent Act 1977 (c. 42). They can only be granted by bodies approved under section 56 of the 1980 Act in respect of dwelling-houses erected after the passing of that Act.

This order amends the Assured Tenancies (Approved Bodies) (No. 4) Order 1982 by omitting an entry from the list of approved bodies contained in the Schedule to that order.
